26. description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) This two story residence is one of the earliest examples of a five-bay I House in Apollo Borough. The brick structure has an ell-shape due to the later addition of a weather board sided rear wing. One chimney, centrally located in the wing, projects from the gabled roof. The centrally placed entranceway has multi-paned transom and side lights. A basement entrance is located below the 1st story porch and to the right of a concrete block addition. The 6/6 sash windows have painted wood lintels and sills. The lack of side windows is indicative of this vernacular styles' "Row House" origins. The front and rear porches and wing are later additions to this property. Several houses of similar style and construction are located in the immediate vicinity. This property is surrounded by residential and religious uses and is zoned R-2 Residential. There are no threats to the building.								(continue on back if necessary)																											
27. history, significance and/or background Built in 1850, this structure may have been the first brick house constructed in Apollo Borough. Although additions have detracted from the buildings original appearance, it could be easily restored. According to Henry's <u>History of Apollo Borough</u> , the first brick house is located on the corner of First Street and Pennsylvania Avenue and was originally owned by Dr. William P. McCullough, an Army Surgeon in the 78th Regiment Pennsylvania Volunteers.
