

26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) This detached two-story building is a vernacular Upright and Wing type dwelling. The ell-shaped house has a wood frame and an asbestos shingle exterior wall finish. The gable roof features cornice returns and two interior brick chimneys. One-over-one sash windows were used throughout the house and in the one story bay window in the wing end. The back porch retains its original wood eave trim but the original front porch features have been replaced. A concrete block garage is located to the rear of the property. The property is located in a Community Development Target Area and is zoned R-2.					
27. history, significance and/or background    (continue on back if necessary) This house represents an Upright and Wing type vernacular construction. Many houses with similar plans were built in Apollo Borough during the late 19th Century. The house was constructed during a growth period in Apollo generated by development of the    local steel industry. The house retains its original use as a single-family dwelling. Restoration could be achieved by reconstruction of the original front porch and replacement of the exterior wall finish.
